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Biting Habits: "First reported in Japan as a very troublesome biting species on man and cattle by Iwata (1935) about the city of Osaka, under the name of *osakensis* Iwata. Recently reported by Takeda (1954) as very troublesome in coastal areas of Saga Prefecture in Kyushu Island. A closely allied species, *Culicoides nubeculosus* Meigen is known to transmit *Onchocerca cervicalis* Railliet et Henry (Which cause fistulous withers in horses)." (Ainauld, 1956).


